Chief Mark Dodson, Joint Base Charleston EOD, WMD/CBRNE; Chief Greg Chesher, presented Preventive Rad/Nuc Detection; Ms. Heather Howell, CC EM HAZMAT Coordinator, presented Regional WMD/HAZMAT Teams; Chief Greg Bulanow presented Coastal SC Salvage & Marine Firefighting. All presenters provided information on what they do and available opportunities for local participation and support.

Mr. Rick Dangerfield informed the MAC Group of The SC TIM (Traffic Incident Management) Meeting and Training that will be on Wednesday, June 28, 2023, at Berkeley-Charleston-Dorchester Council of Governments (5790 Casper Padgett Way, North Charleston, SC 29406) in the Barrett Lawrimore Conference Room and registration is required for both, the meeting in the morning and the training Session in the afternoon, if you plan to attend both. This will help ensure an accurate head count

as lunch will be provided in between the meeting and the training session. Please make sure to complete registration before Wednesday, June 28, 2023.

Old Business

Mr. Rick Dangerfield recapped an issue with high hazards wind speeds and not having a coordinated plan between the emergency services within the tri-county area as to if/when departments will stop responding due to hazardous wind conditions. In our October 2022 meeting, this issue was raised and the group recommended the three county emergency managers to coordinate a meeting within their perspective county with local law enforcement, fire, EMS, and 911 to develop a draft plan if they did not already have a county-wide plan in place. Once each county has a plan, the three counties would meet to draft a compatible plan, proposing one primary plan that would be compatible for all three counties. The goal is to communicate better between response agencies during a hazardous wind event.
