

SCDOT's Public Notification of the Identification of Interstate Safety Corridors in Thirteen (13) Counties

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) is providing public notification to include clear zone improvements within the median and along both shoulders to improve safety within the following seven (7) interstate corridors:

- I-26 from MM 180 to MM 221 in Dorchester, Berkeley, and Charleston;
- I-26 from MM 150 to MM 180 in Orangeburg and Dorchester;
- I-77 from MM 60 to MM 91 in Chester and York;
- I-26 from MM 90 to MM 120 in Lexington and Richland;
- I-85 from MM 60 to MM 90 in Cherokee and Spartanburg;
- I-85 from MM 30 to MM 60 in Anderson, Greenville, and Spartanburg;
- I-20 from MM 60 to MM 90 in Kershaw, Lexington, and Richland.

Improvements are listed according to priority and have been estimated for \$700,000 with Preliminary Engineering in FY 2019 and \$32.5 million of Construction in FY 2019 and FY 2020.

Pending consideration of public comments, the proposed changes will be recommended for inclusion in future revision to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
