55	Unemployment Update: "Unemployment Update: According to the most recent labor market information (http://lmi.dew.sc.gov) reported on 1/18/19, the national unemployment rate in															
56	December 2018 was reported at 3.7%, the unemployment rate for South Carolina increased to 3.3% and the Trident Workforce Development Area unemployment rate is currently 2.8%. The															
57	overall employment landscape in the Trident Workforce Development Region includes 368,841 employed, 10,588 unemployed and 11,002 job openings across the region in December.															
	SC Works Berkeley Notes:															
58	SC Works Berkeley staff assisted 417 job seekers directly within the center. The SC Works Berkeley staff provided 249 services to employers, and created 124 new job orders in the SC Works Online Services System. 141 new job seekers registered for work in Berkeley County. The SC Works Berkeley Center staff provided 29,031 employment services to customers both online and in person. During that time frame 23 individuals were successful in gaining employment through the SC Works System in the Berkeley area. The SC Works Berkeley Business Services staff hosted 4 hiring events with 179 job seekers in attendance.

	SC Works Charleston Notes:															
60	SC Works Charleston staff 3,444 assisted job seekers directly within the center. The SC Works Charleston staff provided 2,769 services to employers, and created 899 new job orders in the SC Works Online Services System. During that time frame 109 individuals were successful in gaining employment through the SC Works System in the Charleston area. The SC Works Charleston Business Services staff hosted 24 hiring events with 260 job seekers in attendance.															
64	SC Works Charleston Adult/Dislocated Worker Career Coach Sonja Randall submitted the following success story about her participant Mr. Jason Weldon. "Jason Weldon was enrolled in the WIOA program as an Adult on July 16, 2018. Jason at the time of enrollment was underemployed working for Sodexo at MUSC and doing home health aide work thru a temp agency. Through the encouragement of a co-worker and a Nursing Hiring Manager, he was told about the WIOA program and encouraged to obtain his Certified Nurse Aide certification. When Jason and his CC discussed further, he decided he would like to do the stackable credential of CNA/PCT. Jason began CNA training at TTC in September of 2018 and went right into PCT training in October 2018. Jason successfully completed both classes by December 2018. While in training for PCT, Jason applied at MUSC for a CNA/PCT position and was hired contingent upon finishing the PCT training. Jason began as a PCT on December 10, 2018, making \$16.00 per hour, working 40 hours per week with partially paid benefits."

65	SC Works Dorchester staff assisted 255 job seekers directly within the center, which included providing assistance to 82 customers who secured employment during the month of February. Center															
66	staff provided 681 services to employers and added 63 new job orders to the SC Works Online Services website. SC Works staff provided 20,701 employment services to SC Works customers both															
67	online and in person. The SC Works Dorchester Center hosted 6 hiring event with 25 job seekers in attendance.
