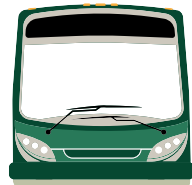
## N. CHARLESTON TRANSIT CENTER

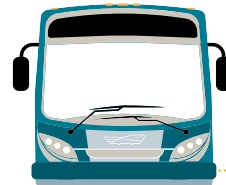

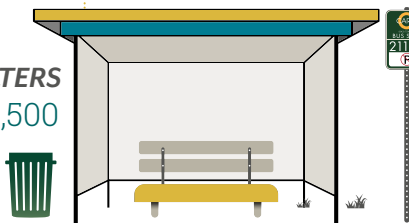

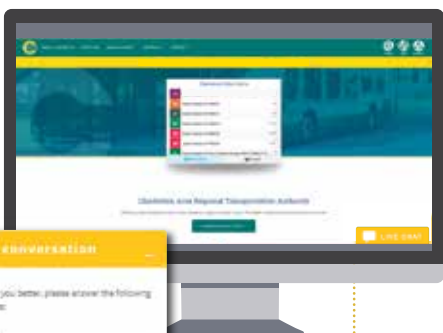
