- 1. Will the presentations be confidential?
 - The presentations on August 5th will be from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM. After the
 Part 2 application deadline, BCDCOG will share a schedule of the 15-min.
 time slots for each presentation. However, all applicants are encouraged to
 stay for all presentations to ask questions and learn about proposed projects
 in neighboring jurisdictions.
- 2. How were the Crash Modification Factors (CMFs) in Question 2D: Safety identified?
 - The CMFs were identified in FHWA's CMF Clearinghouse. FHWA maintains a
 database of studies that document the crash reduction benefit of specific
 infrastructure. However, there are gaps of knowledge in the database.
 Applicants are encouraged to supplement the quantitative analysis with
 studies not included in the FHWA database or document other safety
 benefits that will be created by the project.
- 3. Can applicants reference feedback from the public in Question 2E: Engagement?
 - Yes, applicants are highly encouraged to share public feedback in their qualitative narratives. Consider summarizing this information so that it fits neatly within the character limit or cross-reference an attachment.
- 4. Can an applicant re-use a letter of support created for a different grant program?
 - Applicants can re-use recent letters of support for their proposed projects.
