SUBJECT: **Addendum – Remount Road Corridor Study**

This Addendum No. 1 modifies the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) only in the manner and to the extent as stated herein.

- 1. Does the corridor study area include the Rivers Avenue intersection, or does it begin at the Rivers Avenue intersection (excluding it)?**
 - a. The extents of the corridor study will include just the east leg of the Rivers Avenue and Remount Rd intersection. All other legs of the intersection will reflect the design recommendations from the ongoing Lowcountry Rapid Transit project's 90% drawings.
- 2. Will this study include recommendations for the railroad crossings on the corridor?**
 - a. The corridor study may include recommendations for the at-grade railroad crossing west of Dutton Ave (#631990D) but will not include at-grade railroad crossings east of N Rhett Ave (#632150D, #721435K, #937928X, #721436S, and #865767D).
- 3. Will this study include recommendations involving entrances to Joint Base Charleston?**
 - a. The extents of the corridor study includes the segment of Remount between N. Rhett and Virginia Avenue, but recognizes that the corridor's context and users beyond the Remount Rd driveway to Circle K (1190 Remount Rd) are primarily geared to vehicular and freight traffic with limited pedestrian/cyclist activity. Thus, the corridor study recommendations for that segment which includes entrances to Joint Base Charleston are anticipated to be minimal if any, within the context of Complete Streets.
- 4. Will the selected consultant be provided with the original, editable master files used to create “Appendix A Design Guidelines” in Walk Bike BCD?**
 - a. BCDCOG will provide the selected consultant with access to a high-resolution PDF of the design guidelines in *Walk Bike BCD*'s Appendix A. The original Sketch-up and InDesign files will not be available.
- 5. Under Procurement Opportunities on the BCDCOG website it says the proposal is due February 12th, but the RFP says February 9th. Can you please confirm which date is correct?**
 - a. February 9th

- 6. Can BCDCOG confirm whether they want a full SF330 for the prime and subconsultants, or can the prime and subconsultants' information be combined in one SF330?**
 - a. Individual
- 7. Page 5 of the RFP, section 3 Technical Approach and Methodology, item E. can the BCDCOG provide direction on where this item is referencing in the RFP?**
 - a. Please disregard.
